


Meeting format

Framework of the discussion

- What do we mean by "requests"?
 These are requests in a professional setting, to which you want to say no but where it is sometimes difficult for you to do so.
- Examples of requests at work
 Taking part in a PhD thesis or HDR jury
 Presenting a paper at a conference
 Taking part in a peer review
- Examples of requests for administrative staff
 A meeting late at the end of the day
 Being interrupted in a middle of a task

Possible solutions to better manage these requests

- Identify which of these requests are acceptable
- Be prepared to respond to these kind of requests
- Expand your range of responses
- Set your availability for these requests
- Use a time management tool to measure your availability
